The customer certifies that the only material brought onto the Palumbo Mangement LLC site for disposal consists of clean construction or demolition debris defined as follows:

Clean construction or demolition debris-uncontaminated clay, reclaimed asphalt pavement (grindings) or soil, rocks, bricks, or concrete absent protruding rebar and painted surfaces generated from construction or demolition activities.

The customer certifies that no unacceptable wastes will be brought onto the Palumbo Management LLC site. Wastes that cannot be accepted include the following:

1. Hazardous Waste - a waste, or combination of wastes, which because of its quantity, concentration, or physical, chemical, or infectious characteristics may cause or contribute to an increase in mortality or an increase in serious, irreversible, or incapacitating reversible illness; or pose a substantial present or potential hazard to human health or the environment when improperly treated, stored, transported, or disposed of, or otherwise managed, and which has been identified by characteristics or listing as hazardous.
2. Special Waste-any industrial process waste, pollution control waste, or hazardous waste, except as defined in Section 22.9 of the Environmental Protection Act. "Special Wastes" also means any potentially infectious medical waste or asbestos containing material.
3. Pollution Control Waste-any liquid, solid, semi-solid, or gaseous waste generated as a direct or indirect result of the removal of contaminants from the air, water, or land, and which pose a present or potential threat to human health or to the environment or with inherent properties which make the disposal of such waste in a landfill difficult to manage by normal means. "Pollution Control Waste" includes, but is not limited to; water and wastewater treatment plant sludge's, bag house dusts, landfill waste, scrubber sponges, and chemical spill cleaning waste.
4. Sludge-any solid, semi-solid, or liquid waste generated from a municipal, commercial, or industrial wastewater treatment plant, water supply treatment plant, or air pollution control facility, or any other waste having similar characteristics and effects.
5. Landscape Waste-all accumulations of grass or shrubbery cuttings, leaves, tree limbs and other materials accumulated as the result of the care of lawns, shrubbery, vines and trees.
6. Municipal Waste-garbage, general household and commercial waste, industrial lunchroom or office waste, landscape waste, and construction or demolition debris.
7. Waste-any garbage, sludge from a waste treatment plant, water supply treatment plant, or air pollution control facility or other discarded material, including solid, liquid, semi-solid, or contained gaseous material resulting from industrial, commercial, mining and agricultural operations, and from community activities.
8. Landfill Waste-waste from a closed pollution control facility, closed dumping site, closed sanitary landfill, or a closed waste disposal site.
9. Household Waste-any solid waste (including garbage, trash, and sanitary wastes in septic tanks) derived from households (including single and multiple residences, hotels and motels, bunkhouses, ranger stations, crew quarters, campgrounds, picnic grounds, and day-use recreation areas).
10. Industrial Process Waste-any liquid, solid, semi-solid, or gaseous waste generated as a direct or indirect result of the manufacture of a product or the performance of a service.
11. Coal Combustion Waste-any fly ash, bottom ash, slag, and/or flue gas or fluid bed coiler de-sulfurization by-products generated as a result of the combustion of coal or coal in combination with certain other products.
